everyone who keeps the Sabbath and does not profane it,

their burnt offerings and their sacrifices
will be accepted on my altar;
for my house shall be called a house of prayer
for all peoples.”

Second Lesson

Romans 11:1–2a, 13–15, 28–32

¹ I ask, then, has God rejected his people? By no means! For I myself am an Israelite,
a descendant of Abraham, a member of the tribe of Benjamin. ^{2a} God has not
rejected his people whom he foreknew.

¹³ Now I am speaking to you Gentiles. Inasmuch then as I am an apostle to the
Gentiles, I magnify my ministry ¹⁴ in order somehow to make my fellow Jews jealous,
and thus save some of them. ¹⁵ For if their rejection means the reconciliation of the
world, what will their acceptance mean but life from the dead?

²⁸ As regards the gospel, they are enemies for your sake. But as regards election, they
are beloved for the sake of their forefathers. ²⁹ For the gifts and the calling of God
are irrevocable. ³⁰ For just as you were at one time disobedient to God but now have
received mercy because of their disobedience, ³¹ so they too have now been
disobedient in order that by the mercy shown to you they also may now receive
mercy. ³² For God has consigned all to disobedience, that he may have mercy on all.

Matthew 15:21–28

²¹ And Jesus went away from there and withdrew to the district of Tyre and Sidon. ²² And behold, a Canaanite woman from that region came out and was crying, "Have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David; my daughter is severely oppressed by a demon." ²³ But he did not answer her a word. And his disciples came and begged him, saying, "Send her away, for she is crying out after us." ²⁴ He answered, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." ²⁵ But she came and knelt before him, saying, "Lord, help me." ²⁶ And he answered, "It is not right to take the children's bread and throw it to the dogs." ²⁷ She said, "Yes, Lord, yet even the dogs eat the crumbs that fall from their masters' table." ²⁸ Then Jesus answered her, "O woman, great is your faith! Be it done for you as you desire." And her daughter was healed instantly.
