Sparing the family

It is unfortunate that, at the very time God calls us home to be with Him that our family and loved ones often see it as a tragedy with many decisions and arrangements to be made. By preparing now for that inevitable time, you can make it easier on your family.

The purpose of this document, which has been adapted from the Larrison's Family Guide to Funeral Planning is to help you make those preparations. If you record the information asked, this document will be very helpful to your family in making your funeral arrangements.

Be sure and notify your family or friends that this document contains your wishes and information that they will need. You may desire to leave a copy in the church office to assist the pastor in preparing for your funeral. He can also make it available to the mortuary at the proper time.

To My Family

It is my wish that you be spared unnecessary expense, anxiety and inconvenience at the time of my death. In this document you will find information which I have recorded as a plan that represents arrangements I have made in advance, hoping in this way to relieve you at the time God has called me to my heavenly home.

I have taken this step in a spirit of love, feeling that you would be burdened by greater distress if these decisions were left for you to make with no indication of my wishes.

Though these arrangements may not be legally binding, I trust they will help to avoid confusion that might arise because of doubts or omissions. It is my sincere hope that the arrangements are in keeping with your wishes.

Writing Your Obituary

An obituary may be printed and/or read. If it is read in the Funeral Service, it may occur before the Invocation on in connection the Sermon. Several options are provided below. They must be adapted according to circumstance and may be expanded to include addition information, such as the church and location of the deceased's Baptism and Confirmation. When published, the place of burial may also be included.

Example 1

Our Savior Jesus Christ has destroyed death and brought life and immortality to light through the Gospel. Let us remember with thanksgiving what Gad has done through His servant <u>name</u>.

<u>Full name</u> was given life by <u>his/her</u> creator and was born on <u>date</u>, the child of <u>name of father</u> and <u>name of mother</u>. On <u>date</u>, <u>he/she</u> received the gift of Holy Baptism and became a child of God. On <u>date</u>, <u>he/she</u> publicly confessed <u>his/her</u> faith and was confirmed. <u>He/She</u> received the precious gift of the Lord's life-giving body and blood. On <u>date</u>, <u>he/she</u> received the gift of a beloved companion in <u>his/her</u> spouse, <u>name of spouse</u>. <u>He/She</u> was blessed with the gift of children (a child), <u>name(s) of child(ren)</u>. God blessed name's life with many special people as <u>he/she</u> served God in <u>his/her</u> vocations at home, church, work, and in the community. Finally, on date God blessed <u>name</u> with a holy death and took <u>him/her</u> home to rest in the arms of Jesus to await the resurrection of the dead.
